# PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES August 11, 2020

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Present: Jim Opitz, Kyle Fisher, Elizabeth Chartier, Dave Kulm. Absent: Jerry Webster, Sue Peplow.
- 3. Motion by Fisher, 2nd by Chartier, to approve meeting agenda. Ayes: Opitz, Fisher, Chartier, Kulm. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 4. Motion by Fisher, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kulm, to approve the July 14, 2020, Planning Commission meeting minutes. Ayes: Opitz, Fisher, Chartier, Kulm. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 5. Public Hearings
  - A. Motion by Chartier, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fisher to open a public hearing to consider preliminary and final plat applications for a tract of land in part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 11 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska (Lot 1, Springfield Elementary) and generally located on the northeast corner of Main and 9<sup>th</sup> Streets. Kellen Heideman, project engineer with Olsson, reviewed details for the new elementary school site. Charier inquired as to the location of the front door. Heideman noted that the front door was in the middle of the building facing Main Street. Opitz inquired about reducing the speed limit on Main Street in front of the school. Heideman and Kathleen Gottsch, City Administrator, stated that the city or county will need to address the speed limit depending upon any future annexation of the school site by the city. Opitz also asked about the sidewalk and cross-walk layout. Heideman reviewed sidewalk locations and the connection to the subdivision trail. Chartier asked about drainage plans on the southwest corner of the property. Heideman noted that there will be 2 year, 10 year and 100 year onsite retention basins. A full drainage study will be completed in the future.

Motion by Kulm, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Fisher, to close the public hearing. Ayes: Opitz, Fisher, Chartier, Kulm. Nays: None. Motion carried. Public hearing closed at 7:07 p.m.
