Fund Types

General Fund (Expendable or Endowed)

The General Fund (Expendable) is one of Springfield Community Foundation's most valuable charitable resource. Established to meet a broad range of community needs, the General Fund (Expendable) gives Springfield Community Foundation a way to offer assistance where it's most needed. As the needs change over time, the General Fund (Expendable) ensures that resources are available to meet the new, emerging and innovative programs. Contributions to the General Fund (Expendable) are used for grants and administrative costs.

Designated Fund (Expendable or Endowed)

Ideal if you have a specific community cause, project or organization you want to support such as beautification of parks, establishing a community center or renovating the senior center.

Field of Interest Fund (Endowed)

If you want to help fund a specific issue such as our youth/seniors, healthcare, arts, environment, these funds are used to support a particular area of charitable interest.

Donor Advised Fund

This allows you to make an irrevocable tax-deductible contribution to the Springfield Community Foundation. As the donor, you maintain advisory control and work with the Foundation to help direct distributions to qualified charitable organizations that matter the most
